Called to order at 7:20 pm

Review of Minutes from May 13, 2015

Sunrise Engineering – Clyde Rainey – Sunrise Engineering – Sunrise continues working on the Water Study, using the new numbers given them last month. They are just about ready to wrap up the study. They stated, once again, that the tying together of the two systems would be for indoor use only. The grant, applied for, from the USDA for the Waste Water Study has been approved and funds will be disbursed to the City. Clyde stated that when a seepage test is run that they generally like to run them when the lagoons are full. Clyde will meet with Jason and get us the numbers that will be needed for that test.

City Hall/Offices – Ted spoke with Easy 2 Please, and they will replace the carpet outside the office as soon as it's ordered and comes in. This will come off the office building and also be run to the shop in back of the ambulance garage. Ted made the City aware of a blocked irrigation pipe that runs under the road and is undermining the integrity of the road. The mayor will speak with Roy about the problem.

Krouge's have offered to donate a projection screen for the City Hall. Those in attendance thought that if it was donated that it would be a good addition to the Hall. Debbie will contact Marlo Krouge to talk about the offer.
