Invocation – Offered by Joe Dunford

Attendance: Ted McGhee, Joe Dunford, Shawn Turner. Mayor Bunderson, Kelly Payne absent. Shawn Turner acted as Chairman.

Visitors: Dave Madsen, Mark Peterson, Taylor Ward, Betsey Hart, Richele Stocker, Bill Hayes IRWA.

Minutes - **Motion to accept minutes for May 11, 2011 as amended, by Ted McGhee, seconded by Joe Dunford, vote unanimous.**

Follow Up Business - Stonegate update – Nobody to give an update. They need to be invited to the next meeting as the Council has several questions for them. May Days was a success, thanks expressed to Betsey Hart and committee, 225 people attended. Betsey Hart requested the use of the Hall on Thursday nights that are not reserved, for game night for the adults over 18. Notice will be sent out with the CCR's this week, proposed start date will be the 16th of June. **Motion to support game night at the Hall unless the building is reserved, then venue will be changed, by Joe Dunford, seconded by Ted McGhee, vote unanimous.** Hillier Const and Parsons need to inspect cement ramp at the Hall. St. Charles and Paris need to be contacted and invited to next meeting to discuss secondary water sources.

P & Z – Tim Passey was selected Chair person, members of the current committee are: Tim Passey, Heber Dunford, Brenda Taylor, Sondra Bee, Richard Nelson and Stacy Bateman. Vacancy needs to be filled. Jake Rhees' additional Development has been paid; paperwork will be submitted to P & Z this week.

City Hall – Excess equipment and storage shed discussed. Clerk will contact AIC to make sure that excess property is disposed of properly. Ad will be placed in the News Examiner. **Motion to auction City's miscellaneous equipment on June 25th at noon at the City office by Ted McGhee, seconded by Joe Dunford, vote unanimous.** Portable toilets will be needed by 6-25. Weeds on the Park need to be sprayed. Discussion on charges for a Stake Scout overnight event discussed. **Motion to allow local Scouts have the Hall for half price (\$50.00) pending policy review by Ted McGhee, seconded by Joe Dunford, vote unanimous.** Railing on ramp is under construction.

Water - Bill Hayes from IRWA was in attendance, he discussed the upcoming calendar for water and sewer training, two sessions will be held in

Montpelier on 6-14 and 7-19. After August training sessions will not be free. Wayne Lloyd needs to be invited. Craig Stermon is the Waste Water Technician for the State, he will be in town next week for the training in Montpelier (208-716-2482). Several bills from Sunrise have been submitted for payment without explanation of work rendered. Report needs to be submitted with future bills before payment will be made. Sunrise needs to be informed of this policy. Letter has been received with some modifications of our grant. Sunrise needs to be contacted to clarify scope of the project. Chlorine needs to be ordered (5). Pump parts need to be ordered or a new pump purchased.

Sewer – Possible sump pump connections to the sewer system discussed. Bill from IRWA suggested that a camera can be sent down the line to determine where the water is coming from. Amount of discharge has doubled this last month, as shown by the power usage at the lift pump. A water proof liner can be shot through the line to eliminate leaks. Also discussed was the impact of fresh water into the lagoon, causing longer dissipation time for water reclamation. Floats will be installed soon at the lift station.

Roads – Culvert by Roy Dunfords needs to be extended to straighten out roadway. Several un-licensed vehicles are on the right of ways, these need to be moved. Question about having our streets patrolled this summer. Asphalt bids are due this Friday, bids will be opened on Monday the 13th at 10:00 AM. Dave Madsen wants resolution on the rock in the right of way in front of his house. Council Members were unaware of City's denial of variance request and written response to Dave. Topic will appear on next months agenda for resolution.
