Invocation – Offered by Ted McGhee

Attendance: Ted McGhee, Mayor Bunderson, Kelly Payne.. Shawn Turner and Joe Dunford absent.

Visitors Mark Piggott

Motion to move Mark Piggott to top of agenda by Kelly Payne, seconded by Ted McGhee, vote unanimous.

Mark Piggott would like to get the speed bumps installed. Mark was told about his irrigation line and power pole that are on City property and that if the city in the future decides to open the street, those utilities would have to be moved at his expense.

Junk / Safety Ordinance Memo from City Attorney discussed, city has the right to clean up nuisances and put the expenses on the tax rolls. Letters need to be sent to Florence Thornock and Beverly Tank.

Right of Way Ordinance enforcement Letters need to be sent to Victor Reese, Roy Dunford; as well Tim Passey has a plugged culvert by his house that he needs to open. Wards need to be contacted about machinery on the right of way. Letter will be sent to Stongate giving them an opportunity to participate in the paving project.

Legal – Title – sewer and water easements Sutton / Duran conflict discussed, **Motion to have Clerk send letter to Duran and ask for him to reduce his appeal to the city into writing by Ted McGhee, seconded by Kelly Payne, vote unanimous.**

Delinquent Accounts no longer get registered shut off notices, valve will be turned off and full payment will need to be made to use water. No more collections on the steps to avoid shut off.

Follow Up Items – Mosquito Abatement – Clerk getting bulk quote for Cutter backyard spray. Product will be used to spray street right of ways, residents with sprayers will be given product. Paving project will be coordinated with Kyle from Staker Parsons. Kelly measured all of the streets and proposed doing most unpaved streets. Map was marked with proposed paving. All streets would be 14' wide.
