**StoneGate** – Press Release reviewed, MAP an DAP made from ore extracted from Paris Hills. Environmental assessment –process with the BLM in the public comment phase, Expect to drill sample holes before November 2011. After the test for the products, project will move to feasibility, then construction, this will take a few years. Stonegate agreed with the County Road Department to add 3” of road base from oil road to the water tank, Thomas Rocks will do the construction. Mayor expressed appreciation to them for road pavement contribution.

**Payment of Expenses – Motion to pay bills as presented by Kelly Payne, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Dunford, vote unanimous.** Clerk will release funds. **Motion to use Bill Pay to Thomas Rocks for \$7500.00 as soon as we receive a billing by Kelly Payne, seconded by Joe Dunford, vote unanimous.**

**Public Hearing – Budget FY 2012** – Mayor Bunderson called the Public Hearing to order and discussion was held regarding each line item. **Motion to accept Proposed 2012 Budget as presented by Joe Dunford, seconded by Ted McGhee, vote unanimous.** Clerk will publish budget and prepare for appropriation ordinance in September.

**P & Z** – Tim Passey related that committee is headed in the right direction, meeting scheduled to finish comp plan. Mitch Poulson will attend to lend direction. Impact area needs to be defined, commercial, industrial and residential parameters need to be defined and located in the community.

**Roads** - Paving project completed, gravel needs to be added to build shoulders of the roadway on the first three feet on each side of new roadway. Thomas Rocks will add new surface as they are available. The Mayor announced that BL County agreed to do a chip coating on the new roads next Spring. Mayor thanked those involved for their help in getting project completed, Kelly Payne, Jim Gyer and City Clerk. Mosquito – a few

complaints but better results than past years. Abandon vehicles still need to be addressed.

Paving project reviewed. Letter of appreciation needs to be sent to Staker Parsons and Rick Thomas.

**City Hall** - Propane tanks filled, sign and logo reviewed, Ted will coordinate with Clerk to get signage project ordered.

**Delinquent Accounts** – Clerk has sent out shut off notices.

**Sewer** - Nothing

**Water** – Sunrise Engineering will be halted with work until we get documentation from Smart/Knapp on the annexation and we determine is billing is appropriate. Also in line generation project will be reviewed to determine appropriate financial impact to the City.

**City Hall** – City Celebration reviewed and assignments discussed.
