Follow Up Business

Paris Hills – Wells showing water quality on hill compared to valley floor in bottoms. A consultant company has been hired to assist in the permitting process. Open houses set for May 14, 2013 6- 8:00 PM in Montpelier, May 15, 2013 6-8:00 PM in Bloomington at the Recreational Hall. Transportation Plan will be available at the Open Houses.

Susan Lorenz – SICOG – Asked to meet with the Council to see if the City is interested in a joint venture in applying for a grant for economic development. There is a \$3 million dollar grant available; however it must have a benefit to local business.

Items discussed were:

- Sewer Lagoon

- Advancement of water delivery system (From Spring to Water Tank)
- Housing
- Natural Gas line
- Airport – does current airport impact decision? Paved Roads to airport?

Sewer – Evan from the Afton Office will be Bloomington’s replacement for Eric. Jason will draft a letter to Idaho State DEQ protesting grant decisions negative impact. March 18 to April 9, 790 gallons/per connection per day. System is inflowing at twice the design rate. Sunrise is looking for authorization to budget the rest of the study. Looking at \$42,000.00 for facility plan without environmental, it will take 2-3 months to complete.
