**Water** – Shawn Turner was unavailable to report to the Council. Roy reports positive samples for coliform. Paris Hills has also had several positive test results; therefor there is a concern that the Lab is suspect. Shawn needs turn off valves for water system. New metal detector has

been delivered. Frost plate problem by Don Robb's' (2 years in a row). Determined meter to the main line is City's responsibility. Cemetery has leak in trunk line. Cemetery Committee responsible. Resolution 2013-1 will have booth at the open house on May 15, 2013. Issue reviewed and clarified by Mayor Dunford. Clerk will move ahead as planned with letter to property owners with water and sewer hook-ups.

**Roads** – Montpelier City will patch City streets as a sub-contractor. Seal Coating needed. Quote will be forth coming to save quality of existing roadways. Speed Bumps discussed on Canyon Street. Discussion on hiring Deputy Sheriff to patrol streets.

Speed Bumps will be installed at earliest convenience. Mayor will contact Sheriff for hiring law enforcement.

**P & Z – Comp.** Plan has been sent to attorney for review, it will be posted for public review and publishing. David Bee appointed to P & Z Committee.

**Development Permits**– Robert Ward, Michael Knapp and Glen Bee.

– Robert Ward has applied for addition on the north side of his house.

**Sewer** – Problems at Kears and Hansen's. Paper Trail on Jim Mattson's two months ago. Sunrise bill of \$42,000.00 discussed. Their performance on culinary may influence decision on current proposal. DEQ has mandated work on sewer lagoon dike to commence May 30. Council has major heart burn on \$42K contract. We need to meet with DEQ and Sunrise and define scope and compliance and completion time tables. Concern with long term power outage to lift station by Blake hart. Discussion turned to beneficial use of water bank/ renting water, but not selling water. Jeff Johnson's new residence for sewer fees needs to be started on May 1, 2013.

**Legal** – Nothing

**Payment and Expenses** – Council refused approval due to lack of documentation.

Mayor Dunford will contact BL Fire Dept. for controlled burn to remove debris at Florence Thornock abandon home. He has met with Bob Taylor and walked property, estimated \$15-20 K for property cleanup. Metal recycling on property would help offset expense of cleaning it up. Problem of cleanup mandate of private property, without any ordinance to support action.
