Meeting Minutes

February 12, 2013

Follow Up Business

Paris Hills – Updates reported, feasibility study 16.7 million tons, possibly 19 year mine life. Truck transportation was discussed. Estimated 100-110 truck loads per day at 10 hour days. They will have an open house beginning in second quarter after the road study has been completed. Dave Kramer discussed drilling operations and hydro issues. Liability and legal issues were discussed. Completion of permitting plan completed for fourth quarter, producing early in 2015. Matt Kreizenbeck was a no show. Boat inspection on state ground on 4th North.

Water – There was a water leak on highway 89 at Randy Payne's home, it has been repaired. There were no issues with water testing with DEQ.

Sewer – Meeting was held with DEQ on sewer lagoon seepage and associated issues. Need to find out the source of water influx. By August 2013 need to determine the capacity of the sewer ponds. Dave Matthews of Paris is certified in sewage and is willing to work with us on any issues if necessary. The need of a full time employee in the future was discussed. Wondering if there was a possibility of having a joint employee between Bloomington, St. Charles and Paris, Paris to comply with government regulations? Jay Ward will follow up with Eric of Sunrise to measure the water flow and stay within the timeline. Need timeline cause, cost and expectations.

Roads – Time card for Doran Smith on snowplowing for January of 20 hours was submitted

P & Z – Had a meeting and they felt like they were very productive on zoning issues.

City Hall/Offices – The door has been put in for the garage . Bids are needed for the public restrooms at the City Hall . There is a possibility of three options for the restrooms placement. Winston will be working on the bids.

Legal – Steve Wuthrich can still represent the City in our affairs.
