## **Invocation: Jay Ward**

## **Follow Up Business**

**Sunrise Engineering –** Water discharge reviewed, graphed, meter has been pulled for another project. Data indicates that flow rates increased when irrigation water was introduced into the ditches adjacent to the sewer lines. Billing was reviewed, not expounded.

**Mosquito Abatement –** Rich Kearl gave an overview to the Council of the permits required for mosquito abatement, Paris does not comply, Rick holds all of the permits and licensing required by EPA and the State of Idaho.

**Motion to terminate Paris mosquito abatement program and entitle Rich Kearl to spray as per price submitted \$125 to \$135 per application.**

**Water –**All tests ok, we still have overflow at the tanks, Water meters for Knapp and Smart need to be installed, Shawn has given them all of the components. It was noted that we need to document the price for future connections on Madsen Lane. Clerk will copy council on previous decisions for reference. Michelle Riley attended meeting and questioned the new Resolution 2013-1 for double billing for sewer and water for non residents.

**Labor Day Celebration –** Discussion held to determine if city wants to hold Labor Day celebration this year. 150 year celebration is coming up in 2014.

**It was motioned that a budget of \$1000 for the upcoming Labor Days be approved.**

Picnic and Fireworks with some kind of program was suggested.

**Sewer** – Update on the facility Plan from Clyde Rinney. Sewer flows reviewed and camera footage viewed showing breaches in the sewer line. Council Member Ward related discussion with DEQ regarding routine maintenance of the east cell of the lagoon. RFQ's have been sent out to repair 400' of the embankment with clay. No responses to date have been received. Additional camera investigations are being requested from IRWA. Payment for Sunrise discussed. Dig Line needs to be called to repair leaks in sewer line.

**Roads** – Montpelier City Road Dept. will be doing our repair work next month. Spencer Clement will be patrolling our streets this summer part time.

**P & Z** – Comp Plan has been legally reviewed and is ready for a Public Hearing. Committee was complimented for all of the hard work they have done the last two years. A nuisance ordinance is needed before any enforcement can be made to clean up the city. Clerk will send out templates to review. Public Hearing will be held June 26, 2013.

**Development Permit** – Wayne Lloyd has applied for a shed.

**City Hall/Offices** – Propane tanks filled, Design of outdoor restrooms needs to be completed.
