**Called to order at 7:06**

The regular meeting of the City of Bloomington was called to order at 7:06 pm on October 15, 2014, by Mayor Madsen.

**Minutes – Motion to accept September 10, 2014 minutes as written.**

**Sunrise Engineering** – Clyde Rinney – How is work at Lagoon going? Bloomington is having a hard time getting someone to do the work. Work was set to begin on October 10, 2014. The contractor is about two weeks out from today to begin the work. Roy suggested that we pin down the contractor on a committed date. Shaun stated we are ready on our end and just waiting for the contractor.

With the approval of the City Council, the mayor will present, to the City of Paris, the concept of tying together both theirs and our water systems. The distance of tying the systems together is .9 of a mile. This may provide a secondary water source for both cities, and could be extremely beneficial to each city.

Clyde also reminded us of the Local Rural Highway Investment Program Grant and that the deadline is quickly approaching.

**Follow Up Items –**

Dave will follow-up with Officer Clements concerning illegally parked vehicles.

The cemetery gravel bill will need more follow-up to find out who needs to pay this bill that we have already paid. A total of \$498.00 of the \$948.00 is ours. Debbie will ask Cyndi who the other \$450.00 is some else's part.

On Fred's Spring we are just waiting for the deeds, the surveys have been completed. Within two years the west fence will have to be replaced. A mutual agreement has been reached that Rick Thomas will do the work on the road.

**City Hall and Offices** – Ted will purchase 3 new fire extinguishers for the Hall and City Office.

**Sewer** – Susan Reese mentioned that there was a leak in front of their house that has caused some sinkage. She wondered what needed to be done to fix the hole. Roy will take care of the situation.

Shaun asked for approval to attend a two day sewer training that he would like to attend. He was given approval for any water or sewer training he needs to attend.

**Roads** – Work that is needed was noted.
