Called to order at 7:15 pm

The regular meeting of the City of Bloomington was called to order at 7:15 pm on September 10, 2014, by Mayor Madsen.

Planning and Zoning – Richard Nelsen – P&Z will be meeting this month on the last Thursday to finalize the P&Z Ordinance that will supersede the existing one. They will bring it to the next board meeting for signing. The one request this month for a building permit was for an extension on an existing permit.

Follow Up Items – The surveyor will be here next Wednesday to survey the grounds around the spring. Eugene Findlay would like to see the existing fence on one side be left in place. This could mean our 200 x 200 lot may be reduced in size. He also would like Rick Thomas to make repairs on the road if possible. The mayor will proceed with the purchase of land.

Street clean up: Cars still found to be in violation of the Street Ordinance No. 2009-1, that received a letter, will receive a visit from Officer Clements. The vehicle will then be removed.

City Hall and Offices – Carl Taylor was asked to make some repairs at the City Hall. A water meter cover needs to be replaced at the Hall. The City needs to purchase new flags. Winston will pick those up in SLC. He will also pick up a set of horse shoes that someone left with during the summer. The fire extinguishers will be checked at the Hall. Other options were discussed for a handicapped bathroom at the Hall. Shaun and Ted will do a walk-through of the Hall before the next meeting and discuss options.

Water – Delinquent accounts that received a warning letter will be shut off on Thursday. Shaun stated that he needed to attend a state water meeting before first of the year.

Sewer – Darin & Martin Lutz from Lutz Construction were contacted to do the work at the sewer ponds. Three butterfly valves were chosen as a fix to the problem. Work is progressing at the sewer ponds to meet DEQ deadlines.

Roads – Roy is working on some funding for chipping next year. Doran has been contacted to plow the roads again this winter.

Bloomington’s Birthday – Each Council Member received an assignment. All is ready for the party.
