Called to order at 7:00 pm

Review of Minutes from August 8 & 31, 2015

Motion to accept both August 8 & 31, 2015 minutes as written.

Roy Bunderson, Rich Kearl, Vote Unanimous

Agenda amended to place Taylor before Sunrise.

Taylor Ward presented the city with his Eagle Project. Taylor would like to put a “Bloomington City” sign/rock on the North side of the city. The rock will have to be placed on private property because of denial of placement in the gutters on state property because of the material of the sign/rock. Taylor has contacted Kirk Hansen, private property owner, he has given permission for the rock to sit on his property. The city has received an email that will be filled stating his permission. However, the property is for sale and the new owners have no contract to keep the sign there.

Motion to approve Taylor’s Eagle Project

Sunrise Engineering – Clyde Rainey stated that the Sewer Study has been submitted to DEQ. The board was asked if anyone had questions from last night’s meeting with the Paris City Council concerning the connection of our lines.

Twin D out of Layton, Utah came and cameraed our sewer lines looking for infiltration of water into the sewer lines from ditch or ground water. Clyde brought a slide show of those pictures. Many leaks were found where infiltration is seeping into the sewer lines. Clyde is speaking with a company to repair the lines from the inside. Clyde suggested that we video all the lines in the City, clean them, and then seal the lines. The point of the study is to keep our Lagoons from overflowing. Clyde suggested we move forward with the Waste Water Study. The City has 21,000 plus feet of sewer lines. 2600 feet of lines were cameraed.

Bloomington needs to confirm who our Sewer Operator is. Shaun should know who that is. We need both the Treatment # and Collection # of the operator.

**Motion to amend budget to reflect the new building monies.

Marilyn suggested that Karen's wages will now reflect under Maintenance. Those wages will now be pulled out of Administration and moved to Maintenance for the entire year.

Follow Up – No items

Mayoral Business – Chris Tueller building permit filed.

Sewer – Marilyn asked that when residents pay for a building permit and Sewer and Water connections that two checks be written. One check for each account.

Water – Sandy Sutton has asked that the water to his home be turned off at the street for the winter. There will be a \$50.00 charge for this service to be charged at the time of reconnection. No suspension of the monthly fee will be in effect. A monthly fee is still charged if owner requests shut off at street.

Shaun will get the riser for the valve access or manholes.

The water has been repaired in front of the Hulme home.

City Hall/Offices – Ted expressed a concern, once again, about the steps on the City Hall.

Roads – Roy expressed a concern about the charges for roads that were fixed in Bloomington. An agreed price was not kept. The price went over budget of \$2500.00. Roy suggested that the snow plow be taken in for a check-up. Doran is on board to plow the roads.
