Review of Minutes from November 11, 2015

Motion to accept both November 11, 2015 minutes as written.

Sunrise Engineering – no report

Follow Up – Boat Inspection questions were cleared up, also clarifying of the Taylor Ward Eagle Project questions.

Mayoral Business – The Mayor addressed the question, presented by a concerned resident, of whether or not Shawn Turner was a legal Member of the Board, because he is also employed by the City. Our City Attorney looked into the question and confirmed that he is a legal member of the board, as long as he recuses from votes where he would monetarily gain from that vote. The answer to this question, brought up by a concerned resident, came at a cost of \$150.00 to the City.

Rich Kearl spoke with Dan Fisher about a propane tank at the Water Tank. We are on the schedule to have a larger tank placed at the tank. Solar options will still be looked into.

The Mayor has written up a MOU for the Airport Board, and has given to them.

Questions arose concerning Madsen Lane. Who will maintain that Lane?

The question of how to stabilize the East Wall of the Hall was once again brought up. This problem was addressed once again, and has no easy solution.

Sewer – All is well.

Water – The stand pipes for the City Hall are in. In October the City had a positive water test. Because of this, the City had to send in six more tests. Those tests all showed negative for any contaminates.

City Hall/Offices – Karen Bee has resigned her position as the care taker of the City Hall and Office. This position will need to be filled and all were asked to think of someone who would be willing to accept this position.

Roads – Check with Roy next week about partial dump of gravel in front of Reese’s home and the rest dumped out front of the City Office.

Delinquent Accounts – **Motion to contact all who are 2 months delinquent. They will receive a phone call from the City Clerk. If payment is not made within 10 days, water will be tuned off.**

Motion to raise Clerk & Treasure’s pay \$2.00 per hour, both to \$14.00 an hour, starting in January.

Payment of Expenses –
