Follow Up Business – Stonegate back drilling during the day only until the melt on the Paris sites opens up. Water survey, informational. April 27, Blueprint for Bear Lake invitation for Council in Garden City. Water coalition meeting a couple of weeks ago regarding legal fees and future issues. Review in three months to see if there are any potential issues for group. Post Office meeting on the 22nd of April, for a public hearing. Mayor has written letter to USPS regarding Stonegate potential growth in the area. Decision to wait until after the meeting to determine whether the Council should consider a position. Chimney concerns, state inspections, Justin Jacobson will contact Ted for inspection. Restrooms and grant possibilities discussed. May Days still on the agenda for Memorial Day. Centennial event discussed, dates discussed, latter summer dates seem to be the best. Stonegate would like to direct their contribution toward a community gathering. Plaque to show donations for Ambulance Garage discussed.

City Hall – Out door restrooms needed in June. Tarbet's AAA, source. Propane filled to 80% capacity. Hall available for basket ball, proper shoes required. Policy needed.

Water - Correspondence needs to be directed to Shawn in a timely manner. Two frost plates changed out. Meters delivered, ready for installation. Maps are at the Hall, but not accurate. Two negative samples in Feb. water samples done, could have been a lab error. Grant requiring a match discussed. Leak at Hulmes' needs to be explored. Chlorine ordered, invoices and mileage submitted.

Sewer – Float problem again, manually pumped down, Wayne will stop by and pump it down occasionally. Lagoon expansion discussed. Wayne needs additional classes to maintain license. Future capacity discussed.

Legal - Adam McKensie reviewed payment policy for water operation.

Roads – Review of road repairs. Committee still needed. Prep needed for roads \$3500.00. County discussion for the last three months, pending. RFQ

discussed. Jody fixed the truck. Hauling not available for residents. Private alternative discussed.

P & Z – Nothing new with charter or goals. Line of communication needed with them. Advisory group to City Council. Flow chart needed for paperwork chain and application process. Development Applications for David Bee’s property has been submitted, reviewed. Trailer can be lived in during construction phase, within city, one year limit.

Delinquent Account – Letters sent out. Policy is standard across the board. Shut off needs to happen after notification has been sent.
