Follow Up Business - Water leaks ? – Hess and Hulme's. Stonegate update – Nobody to give an update. Ivan Thornock and Neville Thornock situation discussed. Unlicensed vehicles on canyon street discussed

P & Z – Marcia Wilson resigned. New member needed. New meters and connections are all provided by the city and are using the same specifications.

City Hall – May Days ready (May 30), Landscaping approved for Hall, donation of \$150.00 committed. Railing project ready to go waiting for weather. Ramp starting to break up. Hillier needs to be called to investigate the quality and performance of the cement with Parsons.

Water - Update made with Bruce regarding consolidation of water systems, we need to use it or we may lose it. Group would be convened if there is interest. Sunrise working on in line hydro unit. Investigation in a larger Hydro system needs to be done to see if there is merit. Analysis needed. Paris and St. Charles need to be invited to next meeting. Secondary water source would be satisfied if systems were tied together. Mayor and Shawn will coordinate discussion. Rhees' property has had water and sewer connection completed. Re-certification for drinking water source protection plan has been completed. Certification is good for ten years. Tom Blotter sent a memorandum of agreement for inactive status for his water and sewer connections. **Motion to accept Tom Blotter's memorandums by Shawn Turner, seconded by Joe Dunford, vote unanimous.**

Sewer – Repairs scheduled for next month.

Roads – RFQ's have been sent out. Asphalt prices are coming down. Waiting for responses. Inspection by contractors set for the 27th of May. Roads are breaking up due to drainage problems. Fence line through Mark Piggott's not being maintained, water problem, needs some drainage. Surveying problems with boundary descriptions in that area.

Bid Bond doesn't specify amount. Paris doing some asphalt, other projects in the area as well. Coordination should be done to maximize economies of scale for all parties in the area.
