Invocation – Offered by Ted McGhee

Attendance: Joe Dunford, Roy Bunderson, Jay Ward, Ted McGhee, Dave Madsen and Winston Hart.

Oath of Office - Clerk Winston Hart administered Oath of Office to Ted McGhee and Dave Madsen and they were welcomed to the Council.

Mayor Dunford reviewed with the Council his conversation with the Governor's office regarding the appointment of new Council Members, replacement of new Council members was permitted by virtue of Mayors authority, since there were not any interested parties.

Review of Minutes: Motion to accept the January 12, 2012 Minutes as amended by Roy Bunderson, seconded by Jay Ward, Vote unanimous.

Assignments to Council Members – Roy Bunderson will be responsible for roads, mining activities and the Regional Council. Dave Madsen will be responsible for Planning and Zoning and participation with the County Planning and Zoning. Ted McGhee will be responsible for the Cities physical facilities. Jay Ward will supervise Shawn Turner and be responsible for the sewer and water.

Goals and Objectives for the new Council – Roads – patch and seal roads as needed, Mag Chloride on 50 East and other dirt roads, participation in LHTAC, Grant for Transportation via Sunrise Engineering. City Facilities – new restrooms at the park, improvements as finances are available. P & Z – add 2 new members, complete P & Z objectives. Sewer and Water – Sewer Operator certified, with redundancy for both, either through relationships with other communities or local.

Follow up Business – Discussion on width of the streets, pros and cons with altering widths. Also discussion on surveying streets. Clerk asked to update AIC, SECOG, IDEQ, IRWA with new Mayor and Council positions and contact information.

Water- Shawn needs two more batteries, will pick up tomorrow. Clerk asked to look into finding a courier to Idaho Falls for monthly water samples.

Sewer – After discussion it was decided to ask Wayne Lloyd and Shawn Turner to pursue certification of waste water through IBOL. Sewer preventative maintenance needs to be monitored.

Roads – There are a few places where patching is needed. Everything else is good.

City Facilities – Nothing

P & Z – Tim Passey, Chairman of the P & Z has submitted names for two vacancies on the committee. After review of the names, it was determined that Council Member Madsen and the Mayor would call two new members. Names will be ratified at the next City meeting, by the Council.
