Discussions were as follows:

Water – City needs a metal detector and GPS, Clerk will provide options. Discussion needs to be held regarding point of repair for water and sewer lines.

Sewer – Seepage test needs to be conducted ASAP. Bids from Butler Engineering and Sunrise Engineering. Sunrise could write up the paper work for DEQ and the Sewer operator from Paris (Judd Shelton) could do the testing. Discussion on ground water test, flow rate etc. Wayne Lloyd will help with preliminary work. Clerk will call and get cut sheets of sewer lagoon and valves.

Roads – Patching will be done by Montpelier City soon. Stonegate will help with the expense.

City Hall – Rental Income from the hall is YTD \$3150.00. Electrical work needs to be completed for some new circuits. Clerk will call Ace and get a time frame.

P & Z – Clerk will contact AIC to see if there is a boiler plate for a resolution/ordinance for a development permit.
