Follow Up Business

Bridge Plumbing – Scott Johnson informed the Council of a new liner that can be inserted into an existing sewer line to repair, process is more efficient but costly. Each situation would require a specific bid.

Paris Hills – Update on activity on the hill, further testing has shown an increase of the amount of product from current feasibility study. Water monitoring holes being dug now. EIS and EAS coming, to the public soon. Air quality will not be affected at all. Noise pollution is a concern, location of generator discussed. Placement will be in Little Canyon. Still on track for the application to be submitted late this year/early next year.

Mayor Dunford Arrived and takes over Chair

Amendment of Agenda – Jacob Reese – Eagle Project

Motion to Support Eagle Project which is the identifying and finishing the valve locations for the water system.

Shawn will oversee the project, Jacob will locate and mark the water valves, then flag or put hub in to mark location. Sunrise will digitize map with a Mylar seal when completed.

Sunrise Engineering – Eric Dursteller

Sewer - Seepage test at the Sewer lagoon in process which is a 15 day test. Plan has been submitted to Ed Daily, plan is to isolate the upper cell only then seek a land application after the test. PDF of the file will be sent to the Clerk. Water draft ready to go – Grant reimbursement will be sent to the Clerk so funds can be applied for. A GPS can be borrowed from IRWA. Clerk will order Metal Detector.

Roads – Two signs down, patching on hold due to political problems in Montpelier, looking for back up source for hot patching spots throughout the city.

Water – Leak at Jesse Strong’s. Next Meeting we need to have an addendum for a repair policy. Letter needs to be sent to owner of pasture across from Wilda Hess’ there is a water leak there.

City Hall – Annual celebration was good had over 250 attend. Porta Potties have been removed for the year. Draft RFQ for restrooms in the back of the Ambulance Garage,
