

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON FISCAL YEAR 2023**

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$408,629.00 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE, AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY, AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Bloomington, Bear Lake County, Idaho:

Section 1. That the sum of \$408,629.00 be, and the same is hereby appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Bloomington, Bear Lake County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.

Section 2. The objects and purposes for which such appropriation is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

Section 3. That a general tax levy on all taxable property within the City of Bloomington be levied in an amount allowed by law for the general purposes for said City, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.


Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. The City Clerk of the City of Bloomington is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Commissioners of Bear Lake County, Idaho, in accordance with Idaho Code 50-1003 and 63-804.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the News Examiner, the official newspaper of the City of Bloomington.
